Spanish Qualifying Tournament to the Wizard World Championship 2023

October 21 and 22, 2023



Amigo Spiele has delegated to the **CCCJ** the organization of a qualifying tournament to determine a player representing the Kingdom of Spain who will be able to participate in the Wizard World Championship 2023, which will be held in Prague, Czech Republic, on Saturday, November 4, 2023.

Participation in this qualifying tournament is open to anyone resident in the Kingdom of Spain. However, registrations from non-resident players will also be accepted, as long as their country of origin does not currently have an official distributor of the game.

The winner of this qualifying tournament will win the right to participate in the Wizard World Championship 2023, if he is a Spanish resident or national. If the winner does not have Spanish residence or nationality, this right will pass to the best ranked player who does.

Depending on the number of participants in this tournament, the organization could authorize the qualification of a second player. In this case, they will be the top two ranked players who will win the right to participate in the Wizard World Championship 2023, with the premise that one of the two players, at least, must be a Spanish resident or national.

All travel and accommodation expenses in Prague will be borne by the participating player(s).



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Regulations

The tournament will be played on wizardcards.com on October 21 and 22, 2023, starting at 11 a.m. CEST.

To register for the tournament, you must send the [application form](#) indicating your email, first and last name, postal address, telephone number and user name registered at wizardcards.com, at least one hour before the start of the tournament. Any registration received later will be subject to the tournament director's decision, which will be final.

Tournament structure:

October 21

10 a.m.: Registration closes.

11 a.m.: Preliminary phase. All participants will compete in 3 rounds.

October 22

11 a.m.: Semifinals (8 players)

12 a.m.: Final table (4 players)

The tournament will be played with German deck. The games will be played in tables of 4 or 5 players, depending on the number of participants, following the rules of the game platform.

The position of the players in each table will be determined by draw, in all phases of the tournament.

The winner of the tournament will be the winner of the final game.

Preliminary phase

In the games of the preliminary phase, it will be prioritized that all the tables have the same number of players, and that the number of players per table is 4.

The results of the games in this phase will form a classification by points, according to the position obtained and according to the following table:

In the event of a tie in the result of a game, the sum of the points in play will be distributed.

In the event of a tie in the classification, the highest accumulated amount of game points will be counted. In the event of a tie, it will be decided in favor of the player with the fewest accumulated breaks, and as a last criterion, in favor of the player who was behind before the tie.



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The composition of the tables will be:

- Round 1: by draw
- Round 2: they will be formed according to the position obtained in the games played in round 1, in descending order. Examples for 4 tables (A, B, C, D) and 16 players, and 5 tables (A, B, C, D, E) and 25 players:

- Round 3: the classification will start and the snake system will be applied, in a zigzag fashion. Examples:

Semi-final and final game

The top eight qualifiers from the preliminary phase will play a semi-final in two tables of 4 players. The distribution will be done using the snake system, in zigzag.

Top 2 players from each semifinal will advance to the final table.

Ties in the semi-finals will be decided by the best classification in the preliminary phase. If a tie occurs in the final game, it will be decided in favor of the player with the fewest breaks in that game, and in the event of a tie, in favor of the player who was behind before the tie.

The winner of the tournament must confirm by email to info@cccj.es their attendance in Prague before 9pm on October 27. Otherwise, or express waiver, that right will pass to the next classified.

Any matter not provided for in these rules will be resolved at the discretion of the tournament director.
